APPLICABLE MODEL(S)/VINS

All 1999-2000 Millenia S models.

DESCRIPTION

While driving at highway speeds of 55-70 MPH with the cruise control engaged, some vehicles may surge 1-3 MPH. A modified cruise control module is available to resolve this concern.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify customer concern by monitoring VSS PID with cruise control engaged between 55-70 MPH.
- Install modified cruise control module according to Workshop Manual (01-20 CRUISE CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).
- Inspect cruise control actuator cable adjustment according to Workshop Manual (01-20 ACTUATOR CABLE ADJUSTMENT).
- 4. Road test vehicle for approximately two (2) miles with cruise control engaged between 55-70 MPH.
 - If surge is gone, return vehicle to customer.
 - If surge is still present, proceed to STEP 5.
- Safely PARK the vehicle and turn OFF engine.
- 6. Restart engine and repeat two (2) mile road test with cruise control engaged between 55-70 MPH.

Note: Repeat STEPS 5 and 6 until surge concern is eliminated. STEPS 5 and 6 may have to be repeated 4-5 times before surge is completely eliminated.

7. Verify repair.
