
#### DESCRIPTION

During normal heater usage, the customer may complain of a lack of heat in the passenger compartment. This may occur even if the auto mode temperature control is set high (77 degrees F or higher). The cause may be due to incorrect logic in the A/C amplifier.

To correct this concern, replace the A/C amplifier with a revised part using the following information.

#### REPAIR PROCEDURE

- Verify customer concern.
- 2. Follow the Workshop Manual (section 07-40 CLIMATE CONTROL COMPONENT DISASSEMBLY/ASSEM-BLY), and replace the A/C Amplifier with a revised part.



Verify repair.
