

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may not be aware that their vehicle is equipped with cabin air filters which require replacement as part of the scheduled maintenance. The two (2) air filters should be replaced once a year or every 12,000 miles. Please recommend to customers the need for air filter inspection due to the possibility of filter damage, excessive dirt, or foul odors.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Remove both cabin air filters from the cooling unit assembly according to the Workshop Manual procedure (section 07-11 AIR FILTER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).



- 2. Once removed, inspect both cabin air filters for damage, excessive dirt, or foul odor.
 - NOTES:
 - If the air filter is damaged, excessively dirty, or foul smelling, replace it.
 - The air filter cannot be reused by cleaning it with water or compressed air.
- 3. Install cabin air filters into the cooling unit assembly.
- 4. Verify service/repair.
